Professor Andrzej Granas

He was an outstanding mathematician, specialist in nonlinear analysis, algebraic geometry and fixed point theory (author of the repeatedly quoted "Fixed point theory" monograph written with J. Dugundji). Founder and first editor-in-chief of the magazines: "Topological Methods for Nonlinear Analysis," "Journal of Fixed Point Theory and Applications."

Professor A. Granas worked at the Institute of Mathematics of the Polish Academy of Sciences in 1956-68 years. After that, many years at the University of Montreal. When he retired, Prof. A. Granas worked at the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń, where he founded the "Julius P. Schauder Center for Nonlinear Studies."

He promoted 16 doctors.
